

1.- Complete legal name or denomination, address (including country) and legal tax identification number of the EXPORTER.

2.- A specific period of up to one year. From: day/ month/ year, To: day/ month/year. (this date just covers similars or identical goods)

3.- Complete legal name or denomination, address (including country) and legal tax identification number of the PRODUCER.

4.- Complete legal name or denomination, address (including country) and legal tax identification number of the IMPORTER (to annex the importer's register number).

5.- Complete description of each good, should be sufficient to related it the invoice description and to the Harmonized System Complete legal name or denomination, address (including country) and legal tax identification number of the description of the good. In case the certificate covers just a single shipment of a good, include the invoice number as shown on the commercial invoice. If not known, indicate .

6.- Identify the Harmonized System tariff classification to 6 digits. If the good is subject to a specific rule of origin in Annex 401 that requires 8 digits, using the Harmonized System tariff classification of the country into whose territory the good is imported.

7.- To indicate the preference criterion (of the A to F) is applicable for every good in the field 5. The rules of origin are contained in the chapter 4 and in the annex 401 of NAFTA. There are exist additional rules in the annex 703.2 (certain agricultural products), appendix 6-A to the annex 300-B (certain textile products) and the annex 308.1 (certain automatic processing goods and their parts). TO BE ABLE TO ENJOY THE PREFERENTIAL DUTY TREATMENT, EACH GOOD MUST MEET AT LEAST ONE OF PREFERENCE CRITERIONS..

8.- For each good described in field 5, to indicate "YES" when you are the producer of the good. In case you are not the producer, to indicate "NO", following for (1), (2) or (3), depending on whether this certificate was based upon: (1).- Your knowledge of whether the good qualifies as an originating good; or (3).- A complete and signed certificate for the good, voluntarily provided to the exporter by the producer.

9.- Or each good described in field 5, where the good is subject to a regional value content requirement (RVC), indicate "NC" in the RVC is calculated according to the net cost method; otherwise, indicate "NO", if the RCV just calculated over a period of time, further identify the beginning and ending dates (DD/MM/YY) of that period.

10.- Identify the name of the country ("MX" or "EU" for agricultural a textile goods exported to Canada; "US" or "CA" for all goods exported to Mexico; or "CA" o "MX" for all goods exported to the United States) to which the preferential rate of CBP duty applies, as set out in annex 302, in accordance with the making Rules or in each party's schedule of tariff elimination.

11.- This field must be completed, signed and dated by the exporter. When the certificate is complete by the produces for use by the exporter, it must be completed, signed, and dated by the pre the Certificate was complete and signed.
